This outreach programme will deliver a deeper understanding of the issues in the transport sector, for all delegates travelling with the GTC.

We'll explore a range of topics through discussions with other professionals from the sector in agencies and companies across Europe. The GTC will provide the opportunity to discover, through a series of curated meetings and presentations, the details of progress in Europe across a number of key transport infrastructure issues.

Upon the delegation's return, a national seminar series will be organised to disseminate the acquired knowledge to the broader infrastructure sector, ultimately advancing outcomes for Australia and New Zealand.

Focus Areas

NTRO is embarking on an outreach programme to Europe in 2023 with the aim of deepening our understanding of Transportation Engineering's current state and the trends for the next decade that are clear and emerging.

The XXVII World Road Congress will be held in Prague, Czech Republic, October 2-6, 2023. The theme for the congress is "Together On the Road Again"

The XXVIIth World Road Congress will be held in Prague from October 2nd to October 6th, 2023. This global event offers a unique opportunity for road experts and practitioners worldwide to connect and share insights. The program includes Ministers' sessions, technical sessions, workshops, and exhibitions.

This congress tradition started in 1908 and has since been held every four years in a member country to exchange road infrastructure and transport knowledge. Prague previously hosted the event in 1971.

The Prague Congress Centre, equipped with modern technology, will be the venue, and the historic Industrial Palace will host the Congress Dinner.

The Brandenburg Gate

Berlin's most famous historic landmark is undoubtedly the Brandenburg Gate (Brandenburger Tor). Once a symbol of a divided nation, it now stands as a symbol of unity and peace.



The Rebuilt Reichstag

The Reichstag (Reichstagsgebäude) was originally completed in 1894 however it was burnt in 1933. After the reunification of Germany, it underwent a 10-year reconstruction and finally became the home of the German Parliament in 1999.



Museum Island

Museum Island is one of the Berlin's most important UNESCO World Heritage Sites. The Old Museum, The New Museum, The Old National Gallery, The Bode Museum The Pergamon and The Humboldt Forum are all located here.






